**TRANSCONA BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT ZONE BY-LAW  
NO. 8124/2002**

**A By-law of THE CITY OF WINNIPEG to maintain a Business Improvement Zone known as the "Transcona Business Improvement Zone" and to facilitate its continued operation.**

THE CITY OF WINNIPEG, in Council assembled, enacts as follows:

**Title**

1. This By-law may be cited as the **"Transcona Business Improvement Zone By-law"**.

**Business Improvement Zone continued**

2. The Business Improvement Zone known as the "Transcona Business Improvement Zone" established by the Transcona Avenue Business Improvement Zone By-law No. 6729/95, the area of which is shown as the shaded area on the map attached as Schedule "A" to this By-law, is hereby continued.

**Board continued**

3. The Board established by the Transcona Business Improvement Zone By-law No. 6729/95 is hereby continued and the individuals who are members of the Board as of December 31, 2002 are hereby confirmed in their positions for the duration of the terms for which they were elected, notwithstanding that their election or appointment may not have taken place in accordance with the procedures and requirement established in the Business Improvement Zone Procedures By-law No. 8111/2002.

**Composition of the Board**

4. The Board consists of
  - (a) one member of Council appointed by resolution of Council; and
  - (b) nine members elected or appointed from member businesses according to the procedure set out in the Business Improvement Zone Procedures By-law.

**Repeal of By-law No. 6729/95**

5. The Transcona Business Improvement Zone By-law No. 6729/95 is hereby repealed.

**Coming into force**

6. This By-law comes into force on January 1, 2003.
