

FAMILY SKATING RINK




DELIGHTING TRANSCONA

LET IT GLOW, LET IT GLOW, LET IT GLOW



Oh, the weather outside is frightful, but the Zone is so de-light-ful!


Adorning our streets you'll find shooting stars, snowflakes, rope lighting and garland twirling around poles, hanging baskets bursting with baubles and fresh pine, and this year, even more of our local shops embellished with sparkling string lights along their rooftops.

The origin of such festive lighting comes from 17th Century Germany, where families would light candles on their Christmas trees, held in place with wax or pins, to illuminate the surrounding ornaments. The practice spread throughout Europe and beyond, but also led to many home fires.

In 1882, Edward Johnson replaced the candles on his tree with large, pear-shaped red, blue, and white light bulbs on a single wire. Although Johnson's display was dazzling, the idea of decorating one's tree with electric lighting didn't gain widespread popularity right away. Many were still wary about the idea of electricity, and a string of lights would set back the average buyer a week's wages.

By the 1920's teenager Albert Sadacca, whose family owned a novelty lighting company, saw the potential success of holiday lighting, and suggested making strands of colourful lighting to sell to the public. As lights became more affordable, the tradition of decorating with electric lights became widespread, and today's displays can even be seen from space. Thankfully though, you won't need to travel that far! Warm mitts, hot cocoa, softly falling snow, and the warm glow of magical lights in downtown Transcona makes for a perfect winter outing.





BREAKING DOWN CRYPTOCURRENCY

Bitcoin? What is that? Virtual money? What does that mean?

Many of us are using virtual money right now and don't even know it! How many people today get paid in cash? That changed many years ago when we got paid with a paper cheque, then we got direct deposit and a paystub and now we get an email and we see numbers change on our bank balance change digitally.

Cryptocurrency works similar. You coins are "deposited" into a wallet and you watch your balance grow!

In 2014, when we established WinnipegBTC, bitcoin was worth approximately \$300 and as of the end of October was worth approximately \$77,000. World famous crypto expert, Michael Saylor, predicts bitcoin will 100x by 2030.



Cash is inflationary, which means our money is worth less and less as times goes by. What you could buy for \$100 ten years ago would cost \$200 now. There are many reasons for this, one is because the government prints more and more cash making the cash in your pocket less scarce and therefore worth less.

Bitcoin works the opposite way. There will only ever be 21,000,000 bitcoin created. As of the summer of 2021, 18,500,000 have already been created leaving only 2,500,000 left. Don't worry though, it will take until the year 2140 for the last coin to be created!
