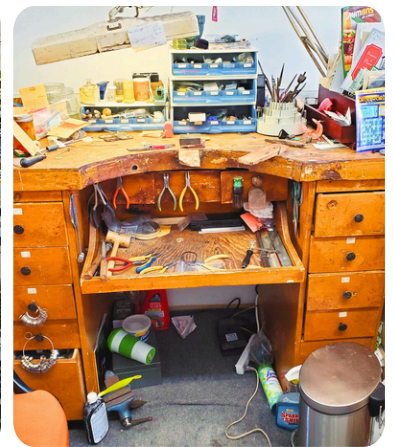

COMMUNITY UPDATE: 350 TRANSCONA SEA CADET CORPS

The 350 Transcona Sea Cadet Corps has experienced significant growth, recently welcoming their 100th cadet and establishing a waitlist due to high demand. This surge reflects the strong interest among Transcona youth in leadership development, citizenship, and structured programming.

Currently, the corps operates out of two separate locations—École Centrale and St. Michael's Villa—on Tuesday evenings, with additional Band and Guard training on Thursdays. While these partnerships have been invaluable, operating across multiple sites has created challenges, including cadets needing to move between locations during the evening, often in difficult weather, which impacts both safety and program flow. To better support their expanded programming, the corps is seeking a single, centralized facility within Transcona. Ideally, this space would include a large parade area (such as a gym or open industrial-style floor), classroom space, storage, and a small office. A unified location would improve safety, enhance training, streamline operations, and support sustainable future growth. Community members, organizations, or facility owners who may know of available spaces—whether immediate opportunities or future possibilities—are encouraged to reach out.
